A #1 best-selling author, her personal development book, The P.I.L.O.T. Method; the 5 Elemental Truths to Leading Yourself in Life, is a "must read"! Elizabeth also has more than 10 books out; a series of small format business success tip books: Soar 2 Success.

Rick also directed and co-hosted Half Hour Happy Hour – a late night comedy show on the CW Network from 2008-12 and is currently in post-production with his comedy/ doc, 1 Minute Comic (The Rob Sampson Story), featuring some of the biggest names in comedy today including: Bobcat Goldthwait, Bill Burr, Nick Swardson, Gilbert Gottfried, Owen Benjamin, Bobby Lee, and Kevin Pollack, as well as the late Mickey Rooney!

As the premier golf course in New Orleans, located centrally in historic City Park, Bayou Oaks prides themselves on their deep history and revitalization. They aim to create the best golfing experience for locals and visitors alike as the only public 36 hole golf complex in New Orleans.

Originally opened in 1902 the City Park Golf Complex quickly developed into a four course facility: North, South, East, and West. Over the span of the years, modifications were made to the landscape that refined the courses. In 2005, Hurricane Katrina caused a complete closure and rebuild for the facilities. The first phase of the restoration resulted in The North Course reopening in 2008. Fortunately, as of April 21, 2017, The South Course rejoined The North Course to restore the complex to 36 holes.

As a championship level golf course, The South Course is comprised of a 250 acre footprint. The layout of the eighteen-hole course, incorporates portions of the former East and West courses and features many of the historic oak trees and existing lagoons that are characterisitic of City Park.

The Ghost and Vampire tour will be a mixture of general New Orleans history, true crime history, local legends and vampire lore. It's about an hour and 45 minutes in duration, with a break in the middle, and a walking distance of approximately one mile. The tour meets at the Voodoo Lounge, located at 718 N Rampart St, where tour guests are welcome to take advantage of a 2-for-1 Hurricane Drink special.

The French Quarter tour will cover a variety of topics dating back to the very beginning of New Orleans history. You will hear about the city's unique foundation, its French and Spanish influences, and how it came to be the city we know and love today. Some general topics covered on the tour are French Quarter architecture, its history of pirates and criminals, stories of some of the city's most famous (and infamous) characters, and more! The tour is approximately an hour and 45 minutes to two hours in length, with a walking distance of about a mile, and a break in the middle. For this tour, the AP group can begin the tour right at The Roosevelt.

See the beautiful former homes of a number of well-known celebrities like Anne Rice, Trent Reznor, Nicholas Cage, the current homes of Sandra Bullock, John Goodman and football patriarch Archie Manning, and the home where Jefferson Davis died in 1889. You'll also see Lafayette Cemetery, one of the most historically significant and beautiful above-ground cemeteries in New Orleans. The tour is daily at 11:30 a.m. (but the cemetery is closed on Sundays). The tour meets in the Garden District, which is a short streetcar ride away from the French Quarter. We'll tell you how to get there and where to meet your guide. This tour is \$15 per person.

AWARDS


